Used lead acid batteries contain materials which if not handled correctly are harmful to humans, domestic pets, wildlife and the local environment.

What happens to the returned batteries?

Returned batteries are delivered to specialist recycling and reprocessing centres. Component metals, acids and plastics are reclaimed, recycled and put back into the manufacturing process to build more batteries and household products.
